

GP Fees For Non NHS Services

The NHS provides most health care free of charge however there are a number of other services that are not covered for which fees are charged. If a GP signs a certificate or completes a report it is professional duty that he/she checks the accuracy of such information. This may involve examining the patients entire medical report. The fee will reflect both the Drs time to carry out the service.

If you have any concerns about the fee involved please discuss this with your Dr or Nurse prior to requesting the service.
